'Faith is the realization of what is hoped for, and evidence of things not seen' (Hebrews 11:1-19). 'Hope is the theological virtue by which we desire the Kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ's promises and relying not on our own strength, but on the help of the grace of the Holy Spirit (see the Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1817-).

The virtue of hope responds to the aspiration to happiness which God has placed in every heart. Bouyed up by hope, we are preserved from selfishness and led to the happiness that flows from charity.

We can hope in the glory of heaven promised by God to those who love Him and do His will. In every circumstance, each one of us should hope, with the grace of God, to persevere to the end and to obtain the joy of heaven, as God's eternal reward for the good works accomplished with the grace of Christ. In hope, the Church prays for all to be saved. She longs to be united with Christ, her Bridegroom, in the glory of heaven:

Hope, O my soul, hope. You know neither the day nor the hour. Watch carefully, for everything passes quickly, even though your impatience makes doubtful what is certain, and turns a very short time into a long one. Dream that the more you struggle, the more you prove the love that you bear your God, and the more you will rejoice one day with your Beloved, in a happiness and rapture that can never end (Saint Teresa of Avila).
