The Particular Judgment

'Christ entered heaven itself, that He might now appear before God on our behalf... now once for all He has appeared at the end of the ages to take away sin by His sacrifice. Just as it is appointed that human beings die once, and after this the judgment, so also Christ, offered once to take away the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to take away sin, but to bring salvation to those who eagerly await Him' (Hebrews 9).

'Death puts an end to human life as the time open to either accepting or rejecting the divine grace manifested in Christ.

The New Testament speaks of judgment primarily in its aspect of the final encounter with Christ in His second coming, but also repeatedly affirms that each will be rewarded immediately after death in accordance with his works and faith.

The parable of the poor man Lazarus and the words of Christ on the cross to the good thief, as well as other New Testament texts speak of a final destiny of the soul - a destiny which can be different for some and for others (see Luke 16, Luke 23, Matthew 16, Hebrews 12)

Each person receives their eternal retribution in their immortal soul at the very moment of death, in a particular judgment that refers their life to Christ: either entrance into the blessedness of heaven - through a purification, or immediately - or immediate and everlasting damnation.

"At the evening of life, we shall be judged on our love" - Saint John of the Cross.'

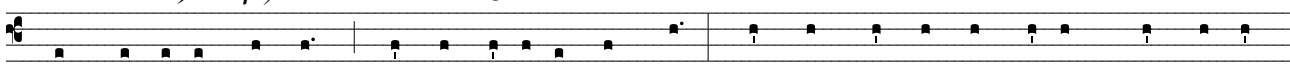

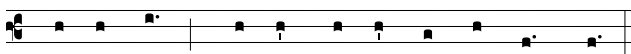
Entrance Antiphon: from Psalm 87.




