The Eucharist and Thanksgiving

Eucharist literally means Thanksgiving, which we offer to our saving God at every Mass, especially on the Lord's Day. 'It is fitting for God's people to offer communal thanks for all the gifts we have received. The bountiful produce of the earth is a visible sign of the many blessings God wants to shower on us through Christ (see Ephesians 1:3-10).

'Lord, have mercy on us...' 'Stand up and go, your faith has saved you' (Luke 17:11-19). In this liminal place, 'keeping their distance,' ten lepers plead for mercy, like the psalmist (123:3): 'Have mercy upon us, O Lord, have mercy upon us.' "Go show yourselves to the priests," as prescribed by the Law (Leviticus 13-14). To make sacrifices of thanksgiving, to be received back into community, back in from the liminal places. 'As they were going they were cleansed.' And one of them, realizing he had been healed, returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked Him. He was a Samaritan.' The Jewish lepers were likely obediently following the Commandments of the Law and of the Lord, and going to the Temple. The Jerusalem Temple explicitly barred foreigners such as the Samaritan (Ezekiel 44:9). The Samaritan's option was to go to his own priests, to worship in thanksgiving at Mount Gerizim. The Samaritan offered thanksgiving and worshipped God in the loud voice of the Holy Spirit at the foot of Jesus Christ, the true Temple, on His way to the Cross. What a truly right and just place of worship and thanksgiving, to fall down at the feet of Christ, glorifying God. Love the Lord our God, worship, and give thanks. May we hear, from our Lord, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you."
