Meditate on the Word of God, in this Month of the Holy Rosary

'I prayed, and prudence was given me; I pleaded, and the spirit of wisdom came to me' (Wisdom 7:7-11).

'The word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart' (Hebrews 4:12-13).

To inherit eternal Life, we must meditate on the Word of the Lord, to learn how to be poor in spirit, to truly follow the Lord (Mark 10:17-30; Psalm 1; Psalm 90).

Holy Scripture is *the fountain of prayer*. In this year of prayer, and in this month of the Holy Rosary, prayerful meditation over Scripture with the Rosary, the '*epitome of the whole Gospel*,' will help us to learn God's Will for us, and to humbly follow, to enter into the Kingdom of God (*Catechism of the Catholic Church* §§ 2653-2654, and 971).

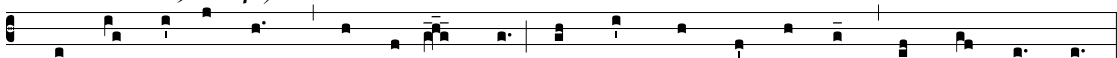
