Celebrating All Saints and All Souls'

As we near the end of our liturgical season, the Church honours all the saints, known and unknown, who reached the fulfillment of their Baptismal call to holiness. United in the Communion of Saints, they contemplate and praise God, and they constantly care for those whom they have left in this world. We can pray for them to intercede for us, and for the whole world (*Catechism of the Catholic Church* § 946,2683).

Then, the Church prays for all the faithful departed who are undergoing purification as they await the fullness of heavenly glory.

Through prayer and Mass offerings throughout this month of remembrance, we seek to help these souls in their journey toward eternal rest in union with the Communion of Saints.

In this month, we are encouraged to remember and visit the graves of our loved ones who have gone before us in faith, and to pray for them (CCC § 1032).

All Souls' is a poignant time for us to *memento mori*, to remember our death, to focus on living with purpose, in virtue, pursuing holiness unto eternal Life, to join with the saints in heavenly glory.

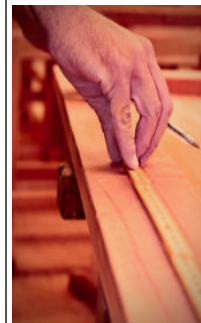

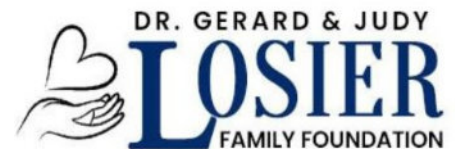
