The HeseD, the steadfast love, of our heavenly Father

Providentially, the Word of God on this Father's Day is about the covenantal love of our heavenly Father, who counts every hair of our head, who hears our cries and answers, and protects us from harm (Matthew 10:28-33; Psalm 69).

This Lord's Day, the Word of God invites us into a communion of fatherhood.

We are given the example of our heavenly Father who truly knows His children in their needs, their hopes, and their fears, and is present and responsive to them, giving them good gifts (Matthew 7:7-11).

Fathers sacrifice for the good of their families, just as Jesus Christ glorified God His heavenly Father through His sacrifice.

Fathers who sacrifice for their families participate in this same Paschal pattern, acting as priests in their domestic church.

We remember the example of Saint Joseph, who understood that fatherhood requires constant, active choice - to listen to the Word of God and to act courageously for the good of his family, for what his family truly needs to flourish.

Saint Joseph humbly sanctified his work, diligently providing for and protecting the Holy Family.

Saint Joseph's hidden, faithful work was itself a living witness to the Fatherhood of God.

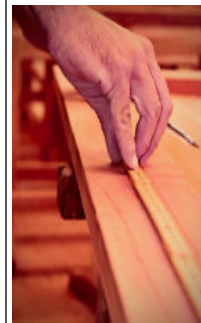

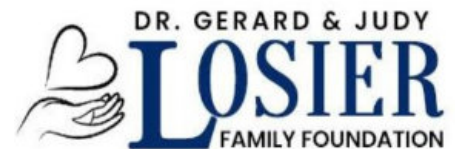
