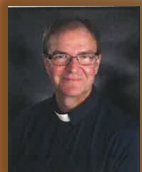

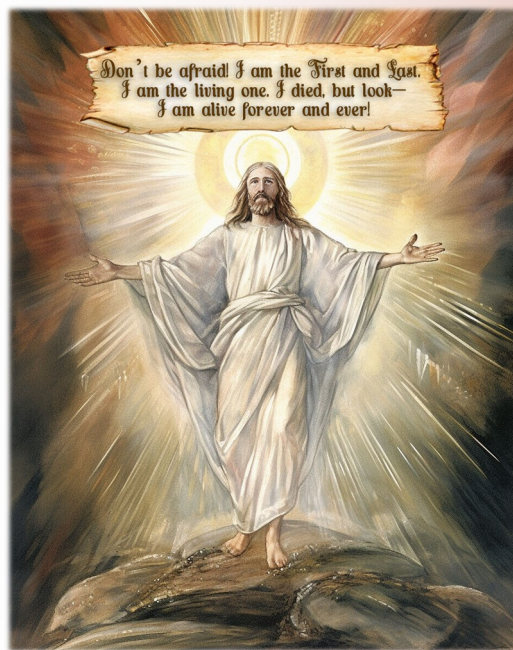

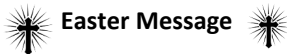

RELIC OF THE TRUE CROSS

A PIECE OF THE CROSS that Jesus was crucified on will be displayed on the alter at St Michael's Basilica during **Holy Week**. It is part of the St Michael's Museum collection of artifacts and its most treasured historical piece. This Relic was brought from Rome by Bishop Louis O'Leary where he studied Canon Law. It was passed along to Mother Kane of the St Michael's Convent and eventually donated to the St Michael's Museum for preservation. The Relic has a Certificate of Authenticity from the Archbishop of Patron, Josephus Maria Constantini.
