First Sunday of Advent

'Advent is season of joy and hope for all who follow Jesus Christ. We must be careful not to lose sight of the true meaning of the season as the world around us hustles to buy and sell, to have parties and plan vacations.

Advent is a time to renew our life in Christ and to thank God for saving us in Jesus; it is a reason for asking God to save all people and for praying for peace in the world. During Advent, we are invited to prepare our hearts for the coming of the Lord — to wait in joyful hope for his return in glory at the end of time and to prepare for the annual celebration of his birth.

We are invited to "make straight the way of the Lord" in our hearts and in our lives. We can intentionally improve our prayer life, with our family. We can attend a penance celebration to help us reflect on our life and come to repentance. We can attend the Eucharist more intentionally, and perhaps bring Holy Communion to those we know who are homebound."






