## Twenty-Third Sunday

If you cannot love Jesus Christ more than your own family and even your own life, and if you cannot pick up your cross and follow after Him, you are not His disciple (Luke 14:25-33). The venerable Bede comments on this Gospel passage and Saint Paul's instruction to the Corinthians (1 Cor 7:29-31) this way: 'hold things of this world as by them not to be held in the world.'

Our beautiful *Catechism* (§§ 2544-2547) calls this 'poverty of heart.' 'Jesus enjoins His disciples to prefer Him to everything and everyone, and bids them renounce all

they have for the sake of His Gospel. This precept of detachment from riches is obligatory for entrance into the Kingdom of Heaven.'

'All Christ's faithful are to direct their affections rightly, lest they be hindered in their pursuit of perfect charity by the use of worldly things and by an adherence to riches which is contrary to the spirit of evangelical poverty.'

'Blessed are the poor in spirit.' 'The Beatitudes reveal an order of happiness and grace, of beauty and peace.

Jesus celebrates the joy of the poor, to whom the Kingdom already belongs (Luke 6:20).'

'The Lord grieves over the rich and comfortable, because they find their consolation in the abundance of goods... abandonment to the providence of the Father in heaven frees us from anxiety about tomorrow.

Trust in God is a preparation for the blessedness of the poor in spirit. They shall see God.'
